### Two \$2500 awards available:

Two awards will be given to qualified graduates attending a 4-year school. Our award payout this year has increased to \$2500 per award.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Candidate must be a 2026 graduating high school senior who resides in Ludlow.
- Candidate must be planning to attend a 4-year accredited postsecondary school in the 2026-2027 school year.
- Candidate plans to enroll as a full-time student taking at least 12 credit hours per semester.
- Candidate is interested in pursuing a degree in a senior citizen related discipline. This includes, but is not limited to health care, social work, gerontology, adult development, health education, counseling/psychology.
- Candidate must currently have good academic standing.

### PROCEDURE

- Attached application must be completed and sent to the organization postmarked **no later than April 3, 2026.**

- All requested information must be completed. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Include a copy of your high school transcript and activity sheet. The activity sheet should reflect school and community activities, as well as any awards or recognition you may have received in these activities.
- Finalists may be contacted for an interview by the selection committee in the April timeframe.
- Scholarships will be presented at the recipient's senior awards ceremony, if applicable.
- The Friends will acknowledge the award recipients in local press releases and the organization's social media accounts. Recipients must agree to this recognition.
- The selection process will be complete by the end of April and all applicants will be notified individually of the results.
- Scholarships will be paid directly to students to help defray costs of tuition, fees, books and supplies.
